

- 1. I will set a good example for my child by applauding good plays on my child's team as well as the opponent's team. I will applaud good effort in victory and defeat.
- 2. I will make sure my child is having fun playing hockey and that he/she is participating because they want to, not because I want them to.
- 3. I will support and show respect for my child, my child's teammates, opponents, coaches, referees, and fellow spectators.
- 4. I will become familiar with the rules of hockey and will support the officials and coaches both on and off the ice in their enforcement of the rules.
- 5. I will exhibit a positive attitude and not embarrass myself, my child, or other participants by yelling or creating a scene.
- 6. I will recognize the importance of the volunteers in the organization and will support them by volunteering as I am able.
- 7. If I have concerns, I will address them calmly at the proper time and place, refraining from confrontations in front of the children.
- 8. I will support the goals of youth sports, including skill development, emphasizing fundamentals, teaching teamwork, and encouraging fair play. I will keep things in perspective, realizing that this is not the NHL.
- 9. I will not shout personal instructions from the stands. I will not place my child in the position of having to choose to listen to me or a coach.
- 10. I will provide a healthy environment for the children; one that is free of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco use, and where safety is practiced.
- 11. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and will stress fair and sensible play.
- 12. I will do what I can to make the experience in youth hockey FUN & SAFE.
